

Clarification

A state law that took effect Dec. 31 requiring home inspectors to be licensed generally bars the inspectors from including insect and radon issues in their reports. However, they may be licensed separately to conduct insect and radon inspections. Those multiple-licensees may include conclusions about radon contamination and insect issues in their reports. The ability for inspectors to obtain multiple licenses was not mentioned in a story in yesterday's real estate section.
